5. MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES

<u>Street lighting in Martin Mill</u> The missing light in Station Road has been replaced. Cllr Minns will pursue the matter of the other lights that continue to require attention. It was agreed that a deadline of 31 August 2016 be set for the work to be completed.

6. HEALTH AND SAFETY

Cllr Minns advised the meeting of an increase in traffic density and speed during peak times when drivers are using the routes through the villages to by-pass the A258. It was agreed that the matter be brought to the attention of KALC at the next committee meeting.

7. REPORTS

County and District Councillors County Cllr Manion reported that a 20mph limit design and proposal in East Langdon is underway. KCC ended the last financial year with an underspend of £3.2m. £1m of the underspend will be used for pothole repairs together with £3m from central government.

Other External Agencies Concern was expressed that, since his appointment to the area in July 2015, the Community Warden has not attended any parish council meetings and that reports received have been of a general nature and lack reference to community issues in Langdon. Cllr Minns advised of the need for the involvement of both the PCSO and Community Warden in the development of a Resilience Plan and it was agreed that a request for their attendance at the June meeting be sent to the respective superiors.

Mr Lear has since exercised his right to record his concerns about the impact on the conservation area via the planning portal.

11. REPORTS FROM OTHER BODIES

<u>Lengthman's Report</u> Potholes are being repaired and, as usual at this time of year, verges and sight lines are obstructed by vegetation. Mr Hyde suggested that, in view of the likely increase in traffic resulting from housing development, a request be made for additional cutting of verges at junctions to facilitate traffic flow.

<u>Playing Field</u> The wooden pole components of the swings have been replaced and labour costs have been met from the grant monies. A temporary repair on the surface of the car-park is scheduled for Saturday 4 June.

<u>Village Hall</u> A second quotation is awaited for repairs to the hall roof.

12. ANY OTHER BUSINESS

<u>20mph zone</u> Cllr Shaw reported on a meeting with Richard Heaps on Tuesday 24 May. The 20mph zone can be implemented in East Langdon and a case can be made to impose a 40mph limit on East Langdon Road between East Langdon and Martin. A number of the existing posts will also be replaced. A series of consultations will be required and work is unlikely before the autumn.

Resilience Plan Cllr Minns advised that a new template is now available and suggested that all residents be made aware of the plan through the newsletter. Flooding in the areas of West Langdon Pond and Lucerne Lane pumping station should be considered during the drawing up of the plan. A contingency for resilience matters should also be considered when drawing up the next budget. The plan will be considered at the next meeting of the parish council.

Vote of thanks Mrs Miller proposed a vote of thanks to Mr Hyde for responding

on behalf of the community to the various lengthy applications for green energy projects in recent years.

<u>Village Green</u> The residents of Church Farm Mews will be holding a Fun Day on East Langdon village green during the afternoon of Saturday 2 July.
